Completing a TNT Collaborative Problem Solving Task

Try your best

Together

- Read through the problem as a team and identify what is required of you in order to answer it. Do not discuss methods at this point.
- Restate the problem in your own words.

Individually:

- Work through the problem, showing all working. Present your method and answer on a sticky note.
- Find an answer and check it carefully.
- Write down any questions you would like to ask your team or teacher about the problem.

Negotiation

Together

- Review and discuss the problem. Do all the team members agree on the best method? Do they agree on the answer?
- Explore the differences and similarities between the sticky notes. Which problem solving strategies were used?
- Ask questions or request clinics where appropriate. Look at previous work for inspiration.
- Decide as a team which strategy to use and which answer is correct; this must be a unanimous decision and each team member must be able to defend your decision. *If you cannot agree, ask your teacher or a classmate to act as a mediator.*

Team Answer

Together

- Using what you learned in **Negotiation**, agree on a strategy and clearly show how you would answer this question. Record your method and answer in the Team Answer box.
- Check the answer with your teacher. If incorrect, return to **Negotiation**.
- Feedback to your team members on your group performance—remember to keep a positive tone.
